
Finally, Billy Graham, for so long untainted by scandal and considered a moral compass for other erring evangelists, has a similar Jupiter-Neptune theme (although the major thrust of his chart is Martian with Aries Rising, Mars-MC and a strong Scorpio/8th House theme). Graham has the Sun closely trine Jupiter and square to Neptune, plus Moon-Mars in Sagittarius on a Capricorn MC.

Maintaining Integrity

It is no small irony that where we have Jupiter natally is where our morality or ethics can be questioned, especially when we've veered off the road of integrity, cut corners, or dined out too often on someone else's reputation (or credit card). Jupiterians will, at some stage, have to take a stand and fight for their principles.

Michel Gauquelin (chart on right), who was born with Jupiter on the MC in Taurus, loved astrology from childhood. He built up an enormous collection (Jupiter) hard facts (Taurus) that scientists couldn't ignore ... so they had to challenge him and falsely replicate his findings to disprove him. But he stood firm against decades of scepticism by maintaining



a stubborn belief in his findings. (Note his Mercury in Scorpio – the researching, penetrating, political mind.)


Jupiterian professions include the priesthood, law, politics and publishing (all of these once considered professions for the noble gentleman and educated few). These vocations were seemingly beyond reproach but are now most often under attack because of abuses 'allowed to go on' behind the scenes when absolute power corrupts absolutely.

Neil Hamilton, the disgraced Member of Parliament, who was accused of taking 'cash for questions' and fought unsuccessfully for

many years to clear his name has Jupiter on the MC. The scandal erupted when transiting Uranus and Neptune crossed over his Jupiter–MC conjunction.

Attracted to confidence schemes or grand theft, the Jupiterian criminal is often charismatic, given more credit than he deserves, and (rarely a suspect) roams free to get away with murder, sometimes literally. He evades the authorities through lucky escapes, oversights, or careless mistakes by the police. That is, until his luck runs out – usually for Jupiterian reasons: feeling invincible, tripping up, or making errors in judgement.

The mobster Lucky Luciano (chart on right) is considered the father modern organized crime in the United States for splitting New York City into five different Mafia crime families. In 1929, Luciano was forced into a limousine at gunpoint by three men, beaten and stabbed, and then dumped on a beach on New York Bay. He somehow survived the



ordeal but was forever marked with a scar and droopy eye. His survival earned him the name 'Lucky'. His chart has five planets (and the MC) in Sagittarius and Jupiter sextile most of them.

Another Jupiterian who pushed his luck was documentary-maker Morgan Spurlock, born with Jupiter conjunct the Sun, Venus and Mercury in extreme Scorpio (all opposite Saturn in culinary Taurus). For his much-hyped film, *Super Size Me* (2004), Spurlock ate three McDonald's meals a day every day (and nothing else) for 30 days. It was mandatory that he take the 'super-size' (Jupiter) option whenever it was offered. Before starting, Spurlock was of 'above average' health and fitness; by the end of filming he was said to have gained 25 pounds (11 kg), become quite puffy and suffered liver dysfunction and depression.
