
4.33 • Jacqueline Kennedy Dies

As we've just seen, horoscopes 'live on' – they are triggered by transits and directions long after we have died. In the bi-wheel opposite, we have the natal chart of **President John F Kennedy** along with directions to the date his wife, Jacqueline, died. Although Jackie married again, it is not surprising that JFK's chart would register her death – some thirty years after his own.

In the directions for Jackie's death on 19 May 1994, Pluto is very active: JFK's SA Descendant has reached his natal Pluto, and SA Pluto is within orb of conjoining his Moon. The closest Solar Arc aspect is a square from Pluto to Venus, another indication of the loss he *would* have suffered had he been alive. SA Mars (ruler of his Descendant) is also eight months away from exactly conjoining his Neptune. (This brings us to an interesting conclusion: to get a clearer idea of our own 'fate', we could check out the charts of those who are/were closest to us.)

In the light of Bill Clinton's Solar Arcs to his 10th and MC (see pages 96–9), Kennedy's chart offers an interesting comparison. At the time he was sworn in as President (20 January 1961), the Sun was conjunct Kennedy's 10th House (TR Jupiter was opposite both) and SA Mars had entered patriotic Cancer (in his inaugural address Kennedy famously said, 'Ask not what your country can do for you; ask what you can do for your country.') Soon after, the Moon reached the final degree of Libra, triggering further diplomatic crises with Russia and a failed military invasion in the Bay of Pigs.

On 22 November 1963 (bi-wheel, right), Kennedy was assassinated in Dallas. A birth time of five minutes earlier would put SA Sun on the MC (reflecting the tragic but most defining image of Kennedy), while SA Mars was conjunct his Pluto (and SA Pluto approaching a square to Mars), and SA Neptune was conjunct MC ruler Moon (the idealized 'Camelot', as his presidency would soon become known).
